RESERVE CHARDONNAY 2018 RUTHERFORD, NAPA VALLEY

Vineyard:

The Vineyard Castellucci is located on the Silverado Trail in the eastern side of the Rutherford appellation. Two Chardonnay clones from these 20+ year old vines were hand harvested for the 2018 vintage.

Winemaking:

The fruit was destemmed, pressed immediately and then cold fermented in stainless steel to retain the natural fruit notes. Racking into French oak followed for the majority of the fermentation, including 22% new French oak, with 16 months of aging and frequent stirring on the lees. 100% Chardonnay

Tasting Notes:

Minerals, green apple and guava with a pleasant, round mouth feel and a pleasingly crisp finish

RESERVE PINOT GRIS 2018 NORTH COAST

Vineyard:

Family grown for 10 years, The German & Son Pinot Gris Vineyard yielded 6.5 tons/acre from their 8 acre lot. The soil is Sycamore and Yolo Silty Clay Loam, while the climate is characterized as cool, with moist winds blowing inland from the Pacific Ocean. The growing season started wet and cool and then moved into a very moderate summer. Hand Harvested Date: August 20, 2018

Winemaking:

The grapes were whole cluster pressed, then the juice was racked clean and cold fermented slowly in stainless steel to maximize the fruit character. It was aged for 5 months before bottling, then bottle aged for another 4 months. 100% Pinot Gris

Tasting Notes:

Floral and citrus aromatics, citrus crispness with slight mineral like spiciness, lengthy finish

RESERVE PINOT NOIR 2017 NORTH COAST

Vineyard:

Family grown for 50 years, The German & Son Pinot Noir Vineyard yielded 6 tons/acre from their 15 acre lot. The soil is Sycamore Silty Clay Loam and well drained, while the climate is characterized as cool, with moist winds blowing inland from the Pacific Ocean. The growing season started wet and cool and then moved into a very moderate summer. Hand Harvested Date: September 12, 2017

Winemaking:

Punched cap fermented in small one ton lots. Barrel aged for 15 months in French oak barrels. Red rose, pomegranate, and a stony mineral note in the nose. 100% Pinot Noir

Tasting Notes:

Pure red cherry dominates the palate and is buoyed by the structure to achieve excellent balance. This carries through the mouth to a long satisfying finish.
